

## **Cattle in Your Path?**

Section 59 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

bans bulls of recognised **dairy breeds** (eg Ayrshire, Friesian, Holstein, Dairy Shorthorn, Guernsey, Jersey and Kerry) **in all circumstances** from being at large in fields crossed by public rights of way.

Bulls of all other breeds are also banned from such fields **unless accompanied by cows or heifers**, but there are no specific prohibitions on other cattle.
